

SAFETY ZONE

For the safety and well-being of all Park patrons, the West Chicago Park District has established a list of rules and guidelines. Please adhere to the rules and guidelines listed below when visiting our parks.

- Pets must be on a leash and not brought into posted areas.
 Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pet.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the parks.
- No driving or parking is allowed in any grass covered area.
- All parks open at sunrise and close at sunset.
- A permit is required for regular use of softball, football and soccer fields. To obtain a permit, please visit the ARC Center.
- Swimming and ice skating are prohibited in all parks.
- Weapons are prohibited in all parks except where posted or by the police. No sling shots, BB guns, pellet guns and guns in cases.
