WEST CHICAGO PARK DISTRICT

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR AND REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION OF PUBLIC QUESTION REGARDING REDUCTION IN NUMBER OF COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, The Board of Park Commissioners of the West Chicago Park District, pursuant to previous resolution of the Board is currently constituted of seven (7) commissioners; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 2-10a of the Park District Code (70 ILCS 1250/2-10a), in any park district where a 7-members board has been created by referendum or resolution, the number of commissioners may later be reduced to 5 by referendum; and

WHEREAS, the Board hereby finds that it is in the best interests of the Park District to permit the voters of the Park District to determine whether the number of commissioners should be reduced from 7 to 5;

Now, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Park Commissioners of West Chicago Park District, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated and adopted as is fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Public Question. There should be submitted to the voters of the West Chicago Park District at the general primary election ("Election") to be held on Tuesday, March 17, 2020, between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M., a public question as follows:

"Shall the number of Commissioners on the board of the West Chicago Park District be reduced from seven (7) to five (5)?"

- Section 3. Voting Precincts and Places. The Election shall be held in the voting precinct and at the polling places established by the County Board (the "County Board") of the County of DuPage, Illinois (the "County"), for voters of the Park District at the Election.
- Section 4. Election Notice. The Board of Election Commissioners of the County (the "Election Authority") shall each give notice of the Election (the "Notice") in accordance with the general election law by (i) publishing the Notice once not more than 30 nor less than 10 days prior to the date of the Election in a local; community newspaper having general circulation in the District; and (ii) posting a copy of the Notice at least 10 days before the date of the Election at their principal office.
- Section 5. Local Notice. The Secretary of the Park District Board of Commissioners shall post a copy of the Notice at the principal office of the Park District.
- Section 6. Newspaper of General Circulation. It is hereby found and determined that the Daily Herald is a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the District as required by Section 12-5 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "Election Code").
- Section 7. Form of Notice. The Notice shall appear over the name or title of the County Clerk and shall be substantially in the following form:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the General Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, 17th of March, 2020, the following proposition will be submitted to the voters of West Chicago Park District, DuPage County, Illinois:

"Shall the number of Commissioners of the West Chicago Park District be reduced from seven (7) to five (5)?"

Section 13. Repealed and Effective Date. All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.
